

# RIDGEFIELD RECREATION CENTER TRAILS



## **ACCESS/PARKING:**

- Ample parking at the center. [GPS Address:195 Danbury Road]

**DIFFICULTY:** Easy. 30 minutes.

**FEATURES:** The Ridgefield Parks and Recreation Center on Danbury Road maintains three recreational trails on the property, all of which begin at the front door. The longest, Woodland Walk, is 1.17 miles long, and for much of its length it follows the Ridgefield Brook, a tributary of the Norwalk River. Picnic tables and a pond with a fishing platform are situated along this path.

The Recreation Loop is a paved walkway around the building, measuring 0.24 miles. The A.T. Walker Way (1.9 miles) goes past the ballfields and provides a more direct route to the brook and fishing areas.

**HISTORY:** The A.T. Walker Way trail is named for a long-time employee of the Parks and Recreation Department who was chosen to be honored by his fellow employees. Trail maps are available at the Parks and Recreation main desk.
