
REMINGTON WOODS



ACCESS/PARKING:

 Oak Knoll Road and access the trail on either side of road at trail entrances. [GPS Address: 35 Oak Knoll Road]

DIFFICULTY: Easy. 30 minutes.

FEATURES: This circular trail travels over wetland, forested areas, and a meadow. It has a view of a narrow lake where peat moss was dug and sold to local businesses. This property has an unusual shape. In addition to the larger green shaded areas, it includes that portion of the Yellow trail to the east of the property, but not the Yellow trail southeast of the property. That portion of the Yellow trail is on a conservation easement on private property.

HISTORY: Fredric Remington, foremost of American artists in depicting army and Western life, lived in the original house. Remington's house, which is now privately owned, was declared a national historic landmark in the 1970s. This open space was acquired as part of a subdivision.
