



ACCESS/PARKING:

- Cul-de-sac at end of driveway across from Ridgefield High School on North Salem Road. [GPS Address: 700 North Salem Road]

DIFFICULTY: Easy. 15 minutes.

FEATURES: Paths, trails, and wagon roads can be followed from the parking area to Lake Mamasco, through a gate to a deserted garden, to fields with bluebird houses, and to lovely views along the lake's cliff. Large beds of daffodils bloom in Spring along with abundant woodland wildflowers.

HISTORY: Anne Richardson donated this property to the Town and planted the original trees and gardens. There is a small field for informal sports or bird watching, some playground equipment, tables for picnics, spectacular trees, and interesting remnants from the Richardson estate—including a huge birdhouse, various stone buildings, gates, steps, and fences.
