ACCESS/PARKING:

 Intersection of Route 7 and Simpaug Turnpike [GPS Address:468 Ethan Allen Highway]

DIFFICULTY: Easy.

FEATURES: The 5-mile section in Ridgefield is referred to as the Ridgefield Ramble. It is currently in the fundraising and design phases. This section will run north from Route 7 and Simpaug Turnpike to the Redding border, near Bobby's Court. This section starts at a lovely pond, then heads up into the rolling wooded hills. At its conclusion is a pair of beautiful old stone walls once part of a sheep farm.

HISTORY: The Norwalk River Valley Trail will be the longest trail in Fairfield County — 30 miles of trail connecting Calf Pasture Beach in Norwalk to Rogers Park in Danbury, passing through Wilton, Ridgefield, and Redding.

The Norwalk River Valley Trail (NRVT) will give all the chance to hike, bike, run, and walk along the Norwalk River, along ponds, and up lovely Connecticut hills.

The 10-foot-wide paved and stone dust trail will be handicap accessible. Currently, there are nearly 12 completed miles to enjoy with an additional 3.4 miles in pre-constructions phases. See <u>https://nrvt-trail.com</u> for further information.
